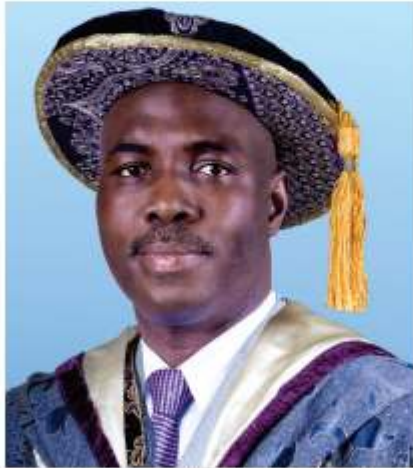

In the area of research, we are delighted to consistently receive top ratings in the computations by Elsevier's SciVal, the quick and easy access to the research performance of 8,500 research institutions and 220 countries worldwide. Covenant University consistently stands head and shoulders above other Nigerian universities in many areas of research. Covenant emerged tops nation-wide in the fields of

Computer Science, Engineering, Business Management, Accounting and other multi-disciplinary programmes. We have consistently enjoyed wide acclaim as the best private university in Nigeria and the number one in Nigeria in the Web Repository ranking.

A major reason for this success is the focus Covenant University places on providing high quality teaching linked to high quality research. Our teaching is supported by leading edge research. Many of our teaching staff have received awards for their contribution to teaching and research. For example, in 2018, the National Office for Technology Acquisition and Promotion (NOTAP) awarded 6 members of our teaching staff patent rights for 11 different life-changing inventions.

Also in 2018, Covenant University was adjudged overall best at the second edition of the Technology and Innovation Expo 2018, organised by the Federal Ministry of Science and Technology in Abuja; the West African Virus Epidemiology (WAVE) for root and tuber crops project, Covenant University hub, received "The Essential Electronic Agricultural Library" (TEEAL) award worth \$1 million



from Cornell University, USA; Covenant University became the first Nigerian University to receive the 2018 NAFSA, Association of International Educators' Global Dialogue Fellows Award; the University became one of the two Universities in Africa that is in partnership with the Africa America Institute (AAI) to provide 10 full scholarships to prospective Covenant University students.

On the students' side in 2018, Covenant University won three awards for outstanding performance at the National Model United Nations Conference in New York; 80 Mass Communication students of Covenant University became the first set of students to be inducted into professional advertising practice by the Advertising Practitioners Council of Nigeria (APCON). In the current session, five of today's graduands qualified as Chartered Accountants. Last year, Miss Naomi Ekpoki, one of the graduands seated here in this arena, won the star prize at the Future Africa Leaders Awards (FALA) 2017. Students of the department of architecture won the first prize plaque Award for the best student presentation at the 2017 West African Architecture Festival; Miss Ubani Peculiar, a student of Marketing, having led 52 other participants, won the "Commendation Award for 2017 edition of Best

Marketing Student of the Year" under the auspices of the National Institute of Marketing of Nigeria (NIMN) and Unilever Plc.; and Engineering students of Covenant emerged first position in the Group Projects Category of the Committee of Deans of Engineering and Technology of Nigerian Universities' (CODET) National Final Year Engineering Projects Competition. The list of awards and milestones are by no means exhaustive. Glory be to God, our eternal enabler.

As part of our aspiration to offer quality education with global relevance, Covenant is currently collaborating with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) under the auspices of J-WEL. This collaboration will further enhance our drive towards raising resourceful graduates and research faculty as solution providers through redesigned education systems, new curriculum, improved teaching and learning modalities, further development of top faculty and high impact research, as well as students who are confident and empowered problem solvers. Further to our commitment to regional development, Covenant has been selected as a Centre of Excellence for execution of the African Development Bank

(AfDB) Jobs for Youth Africa Initiative, designed to equip 234,000 African youths with skills needed to secure ICT related employment and businesses. we have 11 graduands from M.Sc. Finance/ACIB programme.

To the graduands, I say get ready to make all the seemingly impossible possible. You can create a new world, which no other generation could do, because Covenant University has imparted you with a powerful vision. 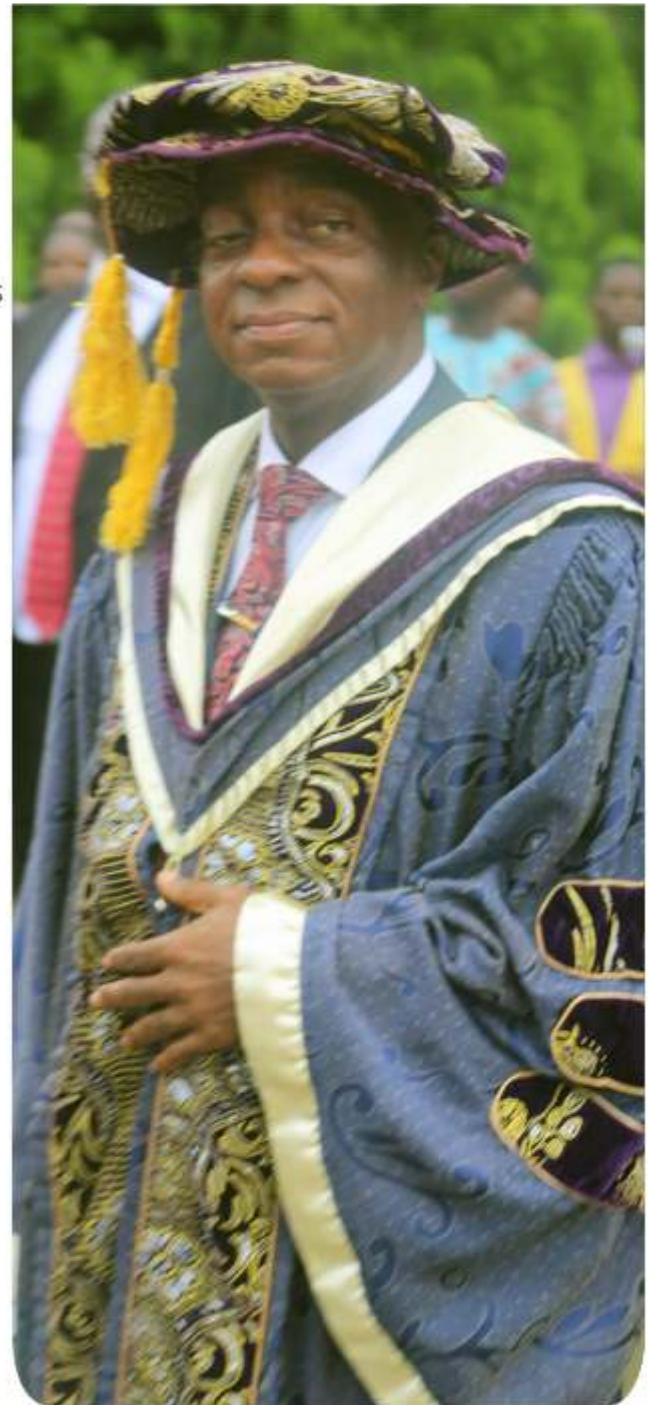

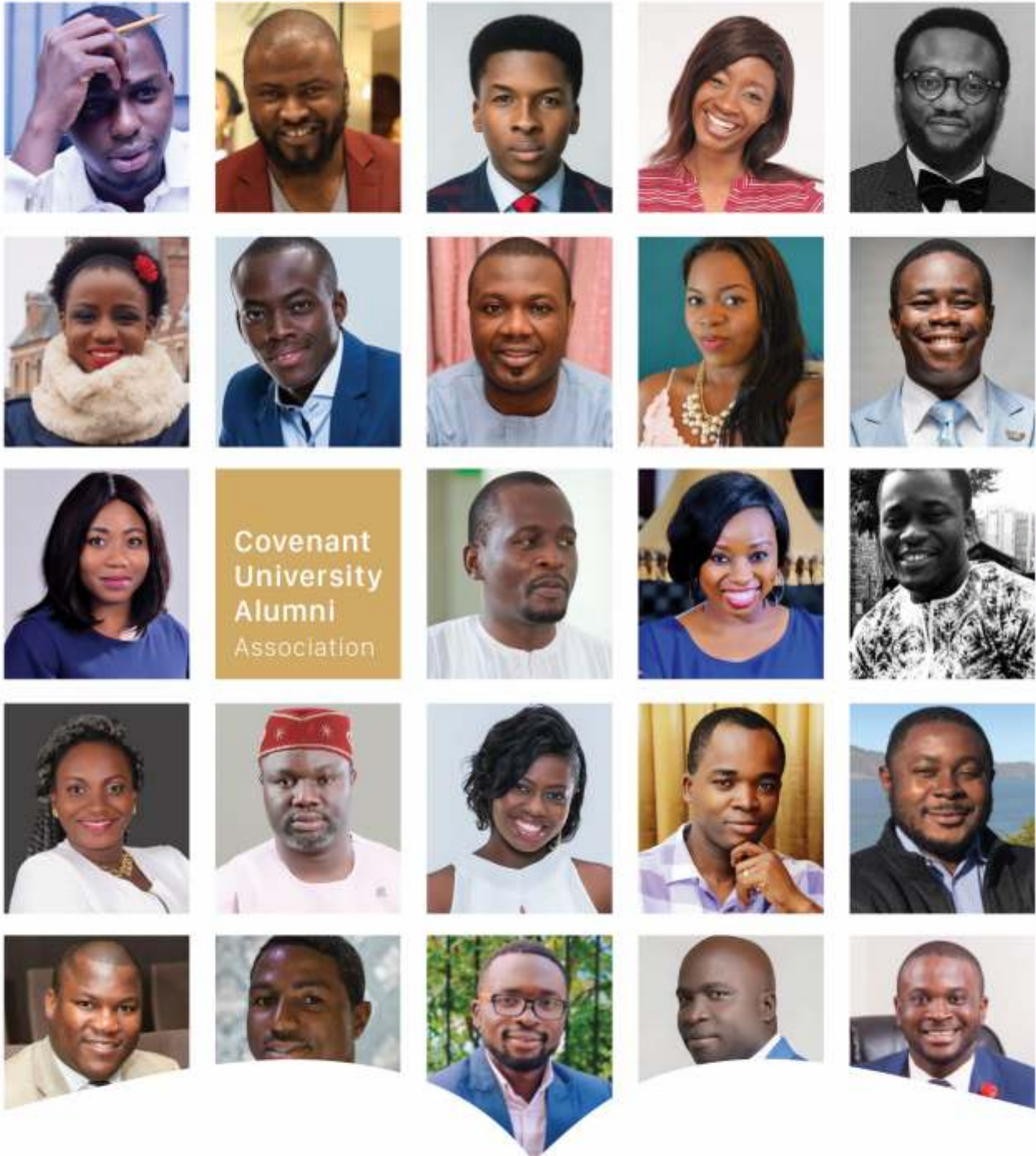

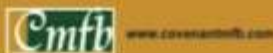
