### **LINKAGES AND PARTNERSHIPS**

Again since the last convocation, we secured viable linkages and collaborations aimed at charting pathways for excellence and best practices in higher education with a number of contexts. Most remarkable among them are:

- (i) Our invitation to the Commonwealth Education Partnerships giving us access to linkages and collaborations with 53 member countries as well as a web-base representation on the Commonwealth Education Page. Covenant University is the only University in Nigeria so flag on the Commonwealth Education Page.
- (ii) Our invitation to the 16th Conference of Commonwealth Education Ministers with its Theme: Access to Quality Education for the Good of All holding in Cape Town, South Africa from Sunday, 10th December, 2006.
- (iii) Staff exchange opportunities with Minnesota State University, USA particularly for sabbatical opportunities as well as postgraduate opportunity for students with discounted tuition.
- (iv) The University, on the 29th January 2007 signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the New Horizons Learning Centres. This partnership initiative will enable Covenant University students to be professionally certificated in one or two ICT related programmes which will in effect help them to meet up with the demands in the international market.
- (v) On the 29th of January, 2007, the University also concluded an agreement and signed the Memorandum of Understanding with the Socketworks. The College Portal powered by Socketworks enable the University to be accessible online anywhere in the world. This will facilitate on-line registration for courses, access examination results as well as other activities which would have hitherto been done only on the Campus. We are happy to report this on-line operation took off February 2007.
- (vi) Linkage partnership between Covenant University and Donetsk National Technical University, Ukraine. All arrangements to get the relationship going including the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding had been duly effected.
- (vii) Academic Research agreement and Collaboration with OMATEK Ventures on the development of E-Voting System in Nigeria. This was consummated on Tuesday, 22nd May, 2007 between the two contexts

#### **Awards to the university**

- (i) ICT-driven University of the Year 2007. Covenant University received the ICT-Driven University of the Year at



the Titans of Tech Night organized by ICT Africa on Friday, April 6, 2007 from the ICT Africa. The award was presented to the University by the ICT Africa. The purpose of the award is to celebrate men and women, organizations and institutions who by dint of hard work, foresight and commitment to purpose, have become the 'reason for the tremendous leap Nigeria has experienced in the deployment and use of technology.

(ii) Private University with Most Improved ICT Programme and Facilities. Also, Covenant University was awarded the Commonwealth Scholarship Prizes and Awards (CSPA 2007) as the Private University with most improved ICT Programme and facilities. The award board - CSPA is an organization committed to the recognition of excellence in the nations of the Commonwealth and the award exercise is being conducted by a Panel of experts and Postgraduate Commonwealth Scholars in the United States of America, United Kingdom and other parts of Europe. This award was reported in the Saturday Punch of June 16, 2007.

##### **International Exhibition for Young Inventors**

won medals during the third edition of International Exhibition for Young Inventors held in New Delhi, India between 13th and 16th February, 2007. The Award was the outcome of a highly exceptional creative work exhibited by both students.

Two other students also won awards in the course of the year. They are:

(1) Terhemba, U Aindigh 400 level Policy & Strategic Studies who won the 2007 St. Gallen Wings of Excellence Award. Competitors in this year's challenge submitted their thoughts and visions on the theme of the St. Gallen Symposium 2007, "The Power of Natural Resources". The authors of the 200 best student contributions were invited to Switzerland between May 31 to June 2, 2007 to add their own perspective to the St. Gallen Symposium in the company of 600 entrepreneurs, top managers, politicians and scientists from more than 60 nations.

(2) Afolabi Ogunde 300 level Accounting, Goldman Sachs Africa Initiative 2007. The Goldman Sachs Spring Internship Program is for undergraduate students currently in the first year of a three year course or the second year of a four year course studying in Ghana, Nigeria and South Africa.
