COVENANT UNIVERSITY THIRD CONVOCATION CEREMONY: THIS IS OUR STORY

It is my great pleasure as Chancellor and Chairman, Board of Regents of Covenant University to welcome you to this 3rd Convocation Ceremony, marking the release of the third batch of graduates, tagged "the release of Eagles, 2008". As I welcome you, I also invite you to join the entire team at Covenant University in celebrating an event which has come to be known in the University system globally, as a rite of passage to mark fulfillment of the requirements for academic and character worthiness as incorporated in the vision mandate of "Raising a New Generation of Leaders"

In making efforts as stewards of the Covenant University vision, we have ensured the sustenance and elevation of whatever makes the university unique and distinct. Our commitment to driving the foundational objectives are as stated by me in 2002, "The core emphasis and goal of the mission of Covenant University is the provision of an alternative to existing regimented training programme of the Nigerian educational system, by promoting integrated education which is life applicable and life promoting".

Having the 3rd Convocation Ceremony come up in the 6th year of our existence following the record time we had the 1st and 2nd, is clear evidence of positive progression, sustenance of foundation and core values, commitment and missionary dedication on the part of the Members of the Board of Regents, the Management team of the University, Faculty and Staff.

It is also remarkable to note that in six years of the University's existence, the University, via this 3rd Convocation Ceremony is connecting with a unique and superior base with respect to the flip side of our current university education platform, particularly as we look at the broader context of higher education in Nigeria today. It is against the background of the multifarious challenges and a number of incessant disruptions to the academic calendar, that we note that this remarkable achievement speaks of continuity in achieving the academic goals that were set, right from inception. This realization has spurred me to take a rear view mirror perspective as I explore an excerpt from my first Matriculation Ceremony speech in 2003, in which I stated that "...this University in the next few years, certainly before its 10th anniversary, will have become a major centre of excellence through its worth as well as an institution which the entire world will be proud of."

I am happy today to note that the Hand of God has been most evident in Covenant

University across all parameters of academic growth. By virtue of God's faithfulness and relentless pursuit of excellence, it should be obvious from the details of the report below that our foundational aspirations are being realized.

The Third Convocation Ceremony of Covenant University is also unique and instructive in the sense that this year, we are sending out our first graduates in Industrial Mathematics, Industrial Chemistry, Industrial Physics, Demography and Social Statistics, Electrical Engineering and French. These programmes are vital to driving our positioning as a nation in the current context of globalization and the flattening forces as prompted by the challenges of the digital divide. The graduates of Covenant University setting out to the world of work will have the industry-relevant skills that should provide the savvy base and the competitive advantage that is relevant for the 21st century context of our Global World.

At this third Convocation, we are turning out to the corporate world the Human Resource component to fulfill the functions and expectations of a University's mandate to provide the Human Resource needs of the public and private sectors of the economy. Also at this year's convocation ceremony, the very first Covenant University home grown M.Sc Architecture graduates are part of the listing following a six year training period in the University. Covenant University today boasts of having one of the best Architecture programmes in Nigeria, with a number of eminent and distinguished professors steering the ship of the School and supporting innovations and charting new directions for Architecture particularly from our indigenous base. The Department of Architecture among others has full accreditation from both the National Universities Commission and the Professional bodies (NIA/ARCON) and is now getting set for international accreditation as its next goal.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES IN COVENANT UNIVERSITY

At the inception, the following 16 programmes were introduced in the University and they all graduated students in 2006: Accounting, Business Administration, Industrial Relations & Human Resource Management, Marketing, Economics, Banking & Finance, International Relations, Policy & Strategic Studies, Political Science, Psychology, English Language, Literature In English, Mass Communication, Public Relations & Advertising, Sociology, Computer Science, Management Information System.

However, by 2007, our academic programme had increased to 21 having the following newly introduced programmes along with the initial: Public Administration, Architecture, Computer Engineering, Estate Management, and Information & Communication Technology. The increase in the number of our academic programme is in relation to our

goal of building human capacity in the area of Science, Engineering and Technology. Subsequently more programmes were added: Demography & Social Statistics, French, Industrial Chemistry, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Industrial Mathematics and Industrial Physics. The increase in the number of faculty especially at the senior level has been a great asset for managing the qualitative increase in the number of programmes.

ACADEMIC AND PROFESSIONAL ACCREDITATION OF OUR PROGRAMMES

Following our growth experience, the academic programmes were subjected to external validation from both academic and professional regulatory bodies. This led to the National Universities Commission's accreditation of our entire academic programme from 2005 to date. Consequent upon the NUC Resource Verification visit to Nigerian Universities in 2007, Covenant University presented eleven (11) academic programmes for the December accreditation exercise in the same year and all the programmes were accredited by the National Universities Commission.

The following programmes were also accredited by the following professional bodies:

- (1) B.Sc. / M.Sc Architecture - accredited by Architects Registration Council of Nigeria/Nigerian Institute of Architect (ARCON.NIA)
- (2) B.Sc. Estate Management – Institute of Estate Surveyors and Valuers of Nigeria
- (3) B.Sc. Banking and Finance – accredited by ACIBN
- (4) B.Sc. Accounting – accredited by Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria
- (5) B.Eng. Electrical and Electronic Engineering accredited by COREN

OUR UNIQUENESS

Some of the areas of uniqueness of our graduates are the infusion and inclusion of custom built programmes such as Entrepreneurial*Development Studies (EDS), Total Man Concept (TMC), Towards a Total Graduate programme (TTG) as well as the work study programme. While the fundamental philosophy and essence of TMC is premised on accessing the total make-up of human kind from the spirit, soul and body in order to prepare and equip our students with the relevant life skills and mindset which will provide them anchorage as they wade through the tidal waters of life, TTG is an important aspect of the evolving learning culture at Covenant University for our graduating class. This is a unique infusion to ensure that students of Covenant University are turned out as worthy in character and for leadership at the point of graduation. The course, which is integrated into the University's holistic and life-applicable curriculum, is designed to specially package the students and deliver them to their world upon graduation, as agents of change set to take charge of their environment and break the barriers and limitations confronting our nation and continent at large.

The Entrepreneurial Development Studies (EDS) is a custom-built programme which is an all semester programme and compulsory for all students of the University irrespective of the

student's chosen field of study. It involves both theory and practical. The operations of this unit are housed in the Centre for Entrepreneurial Development Studies (CEDs). This Centre which takes care of the practical and vocational aspects of EDS has been organizing workshops and seminars in such areas as Fish Farming for Practicing and Prospective Entrepreneurs as well as other viable areas which external communities have been benefiting from.

ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE COVENANT UNIVERSITY ALUMNI

These special curricula are already resulting in humbling external validation. Reports reaching the University from the employers of our graduates have been very encouraging despite the fact that we do not expect the contrary. Spread across the nation and overseas countries, our graduates have been performing extremely well in the banking sector, industries, politics and academic settings while some of them have become employers of labour thus helping to address the unemployment challenges in our Nation. One of these includes a transport company called CAsETA Transports.

Currently, 21 Alumnus of this University are on their M.Sc. Programmes as Graduate Assistants in various academic disciplines here in Covenant University, while quite a number of them are pursuing their postgraduate education in overseas countries including University of Bolton, University of Stanford, Coventry University, University of Leeds, Baruch College, New York, College of New Caledonia, University of Greenwich, Kent University, Uni. of Bedfordshire, Birmingham city University, to mention but few.

Students' Awards/Recognition

- (i) A student in the Department of Architecture, College of Science and Technology emerged as Third Best Overall Candidate in the First Bank Undergraduate Essay Competition for the year 2007.
- (ii) Two (2) 400 Level Elect/Elect. students won Medals during the International Exhibition for Young Inventors (IEYI).
- (iii) Covenant University students emerged the best at the just concluded Nigerian Model United Nations Society (NIGIMUNS) Conference in Abuja. The University delegation made of four students representing four different countries as Ambassadors and two staff emerged as the Best School Delegation at the Conference.
- (iv) A 300 level student in Accounting was selected as a Principal candidate for the study of the US Institute for Student Leaders USF-08. She will be hosted by the University of Arkansas, USA from June 29 to August 3, 2008 along with other candidates from across the globe.
- (v) A 400 level student of Electrical and Electronic Engineering, College of Science and Technology who invented the INBUILT POWER DEVICE (IPD) that won medals at the International Exhibition of Young Inventors in New Delhi, India in February 2007 was nominated to represent Covenant University at the competition. He carried out his SIWES at the Confederation of India Industries, New Delhi, India under the International Industrial Training Scheme (IITS).
- (vi) A 400 level student of Computer Engineering won a gold medal in far away Thailand at the International Invention Exhibition and Convention organized by the National Research Council of Thailand as part of the First International Inventors' Day Convention of the International Federation of Inventors' Association (IFIA) February 2-5, 2008. His invention, the "eCrone Timekeeper", is an effective and reliable stand-alone electronic gadget suitable for use in schools for time-keeping purposes.

CONFERENCES/WORKSHOPS SPONSORSHIP

Research results are continually being disseminated via local and international conferences as well as journals of high impact factor. About 65 members of our academic staff enjoyed sponsorship to attend local and international Conferences/Workshops to present

academic papers which were the outcome of their research endeavours. Covenant University will continue to encourage research activities and do everything within its academic limit to further assist any Faculty in the areas of research and conference attendance.

RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES AT COVENANT UNIVERSITY

A University's relevance is obvious only to the extent that it is able to proffer meaningful smart solutions to the challenges of its immediate context. It is in the pursuance of this that we set out to generate a research base that seeks relevant solutions for challenges that are peculiar to Africa which may not find a fit in Western contraptions addressing same. To this effect, we have established a Research and Development Centre in Covenant University with the following mandate:

- The provision of a viable platform for Research and Development Initiatives at Covenant University;
- Instituting an all embracing and comprehensive research policy for the University in line with the needs of our immediate environment and context – linking research to the real issues out there in our world – a solution focused approach;
- Linkage and collaboration with national and international industrial / organizational context as stipulated in our Endowment Mandate;
- Flagging off from the research, innovation and development platform, centre of excellence and institutes devoted purely to research;
- Creation of an environment and base that will stimulate research and development activities – fairs, exhibitions, clusters, etc. so as to engage Faculty to raise a research consciousness and culture.

To this end, the University was recently given a grant of N50 million for the immediate establishment of a Research and Development Centre. The Centre has taken off with fully furnished facility and personnel. Similarly, a whopping sum of N1.165 billion Naira was approved early June for purchase of Teaching and Research equipment in the College of Science and Technology. This is apart from over N500 million spent in the course of the 2007/2008 session on similar equipment. It is our intention to ensure that focused attention is devoted to the promotion of research and the nurturing of its findings into products so that our nation may come to global recognition in inventions and innovations.

Research Breakthroughs At Covenant University

The research work by both students and faculty of Covenant University are solution-focused. Within the last three years, our research efforts have yielded a number of commercial products of application to the generality of people. Amongst others, the

following are worth noting for interested Industrialists and Investors:

- (1) Variety of Security Devices. The functions of these devices include: automatic message relay to security agents or any person desired at the presence of an unwanted intruder; and Mounted Surveillance camera with ability to survey 360 degrees round the surveyed property like Banks, Estates, Company premises etc and also having the ability to monitor in utter darkness.
- (2) Variety of domestic energy saving devices. These energy saving devices include: (a) Remotely controlled home appliances device (b) Automatic power switch-off device at the last count of people in the room or house (c) Long distance home appliances switch-off device through personal handset
- (3) Dispensing Machines. Our Automatic drug dispensing machine conveys the stored drug to the patient at the programmed times while the Mineral drink dispensing machine dispenses a measured quantity of drink according to the amount paid by a customer.
- (4) Automobile Products: Two of our products useful to vehicle owners include the Vehicle Radiator Coolant and the car interior battery operated vacuum cleaner. Related to this are our variety of electronic car park manager. These are computerized car park entrance and exit machine that automatically open to recognized vehicles' codes.
- (5) Building Equipment. Our mechanized building blocks plum eliminates slanting wall challenge and increases the number of blocks that can be laid per day by a bricklayer by 30 percent.

These and many others are the evidences of our success story at Covenant University. We invite all investors in relevant areas to join us in turning these output into great products. We invite you to visit our Exhibition Pavilion at the ground floor of the Center for Learning Resources (Library)

As a University, we will continue to take steps towards the great future we envision, knowing that we must set out to carve out visible pathways to walk, for our nation and continent. We must also set out to address issues that are indigenous to our base and institute values and practices that will truly define us as a people and give us a place of relevance in the global scheme of things. I am therefore happy to announce as part of this years Convocation Ceremony, the establishment of the Covenant University African Development Centre which will provide well researched indigenous solutions to socio-political and industrial challenges of Africa. The construction of the Centre is on and is expected to be completed before the end of the 2008. The centre will host leaders from all over the continents of the world as they identify solutions to the many challenges besetting us on the national, continental and global platforms.

Long live Covenant University, long live the Federal Republic of Nigeria and long live the great people of Africa.

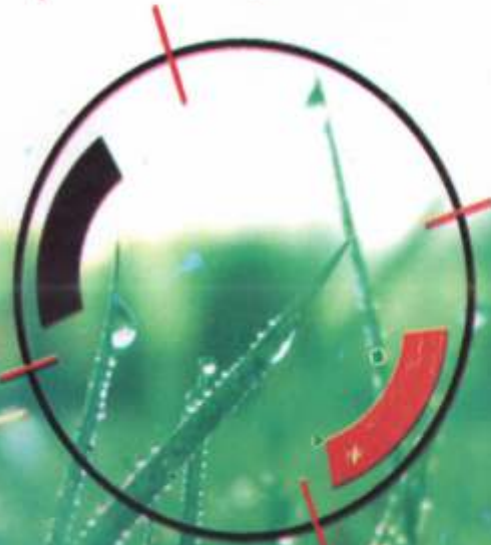

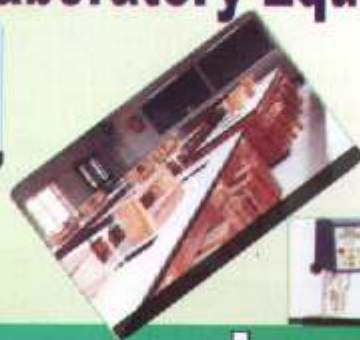

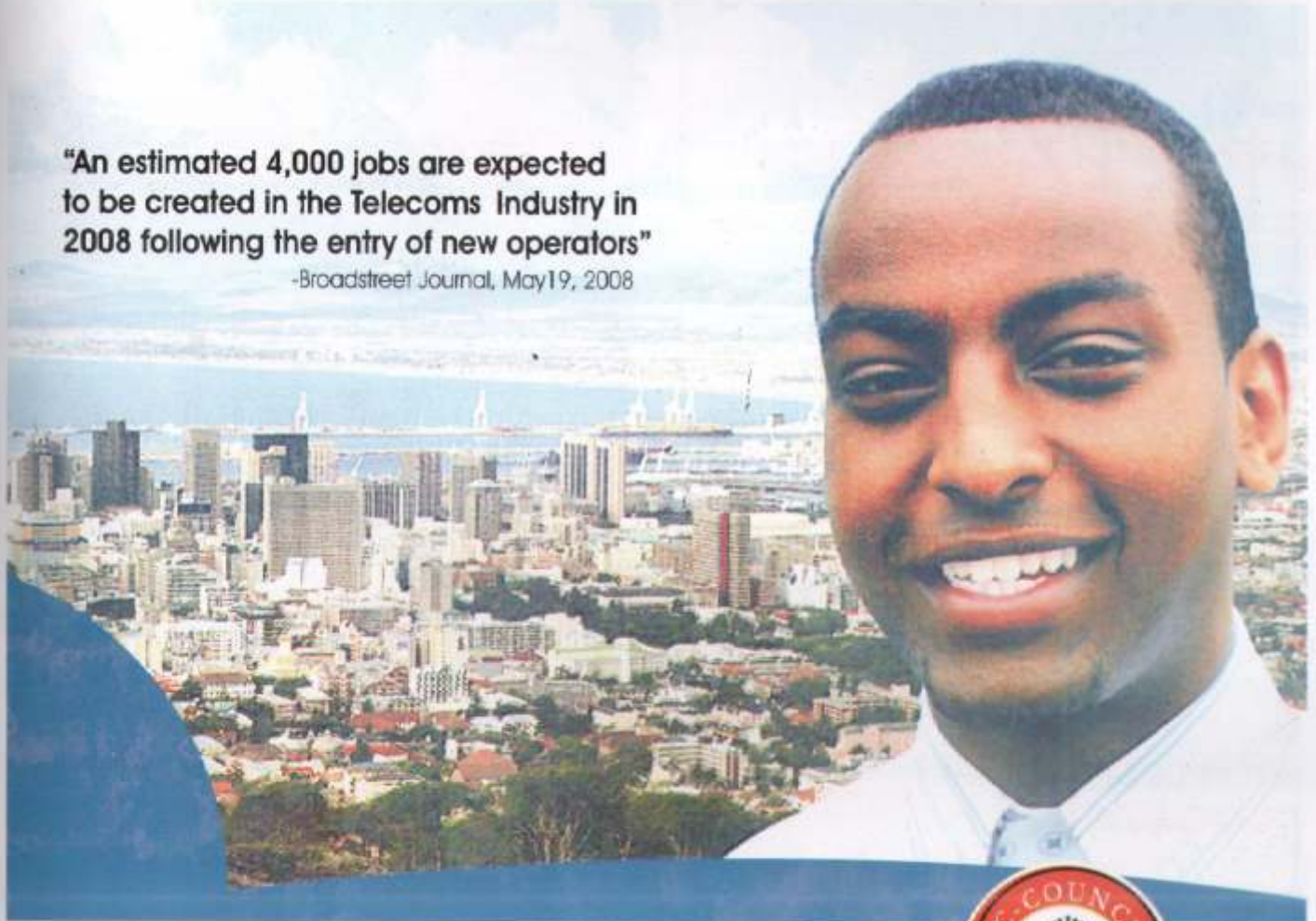
