

## From the Chancellor

#### FROM THE CHANCELLOR

On this occasion of the 4th Convocation Ceremony of Covenant University, it is my great pleasure to welcome you as Chancellor and Chairman Board of Regents, to this auspicious event on the platform of the vision base, as another batch of eagles are released to their world to go and make a difference.

This period marks, in our developmental history, a season when the University marks another season of harvests, as the vision which birthed the University - "raising a new generation of leaders" -is actualized. It also marks the fulfilment of our commitment to the Nigerian nation, African Continent and the Global Community at large.

However, the 4<sup>th</sup> Convocation Ceremony is unique in many ways as this is the first time that we will be graduating students from all Departments in the University. Our special graduation preparatory programme, Towards a Total Graduate (TTG) is also designed to specially package the students for the world-of work upon graduation, as agents of change, set to take charge of their environment and break the barriers of limitation confronting the nations and humanity at large.

#### THE COVENANT UNIVERSITY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

As a validation of the living testimony of our Vision, we have continuously found fulfilment in the good news emerging from the Alumni base. With the release of three sets of Eagles – 2006, 2007, and 2008- the Covenant University Alumni Association has continued to evolve a powerful network of members who are already taking prime places in the world of work and are soaring higher and higher into their glorious destinies.

Covenant University graduates have consistently remained the toast of employers of labour, who realizing the credible base, more often than not have continued to waive recruitment examination processes for them. Spread across the nation and overseas countries, our graduates have been performing extremely well in the banking and other industries, as well as in politics and academic settings. Some of them have become employers of labour thus helping to address the unemployment challenges in our Nation.

Currently, 27 members of the Association are on their Ph.D. Programmes as full Faculty in various academic disciplines here in Covenant University, while quite a number of them are pursuing their postgraduate education in universities in Nigeria and other parts of the World.

#### FOCUS ON SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

At Covenant University we recognize the vital roles which Science and Technology play in the development of any society and it is in response to this that our College of Science and Technology continues to evolve and expand not only in our Engineering programmes but also in our Science base.

I am pleased to announce that Covenant University has continued to grow and make strides towards our given vision of raising a new generation of leaders for the continent through the vehicle of life applicable education. These strides have taken the form of continuous growth in our human capacity base consolidating the engineering base of the College of Science and Technology.

#### RESEARCH

In a move to give the desired focus and momentum to the University's research aspiration, a grant of N50 million was injected into the take-off of the new Covenant University Centre for Research and Development (CUCERD) which came into existence in October 2008. The Centre is the physical infrastructure for the development and broadening of the University's Research and Development programmes.

The Centre co-ordinates the initiation and evaluation of the University's Research Projects. It also serves as a platform to oversee the Technical Quality of Research Proposals for University sponsorship and to forge research partnership and linkage with government agencies, industries and other Research Institutes.

As we march to our 7<sup>th</sup> year as a University in October this year, we can proudly say that we have come a long way in the realization of our vision. Though the journey has just begun, we are confident that in these 6 years, we have been able among other things to:

- pioneer excellence in the University's statutory functions and rights at the frontiers of knowledge in the world;
