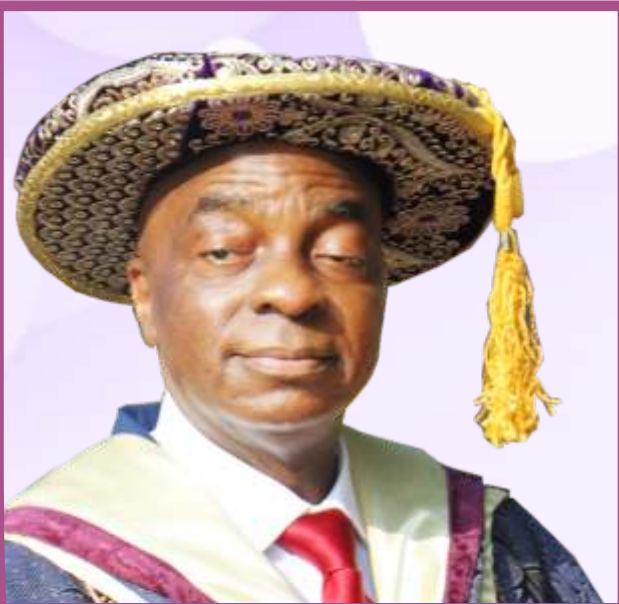

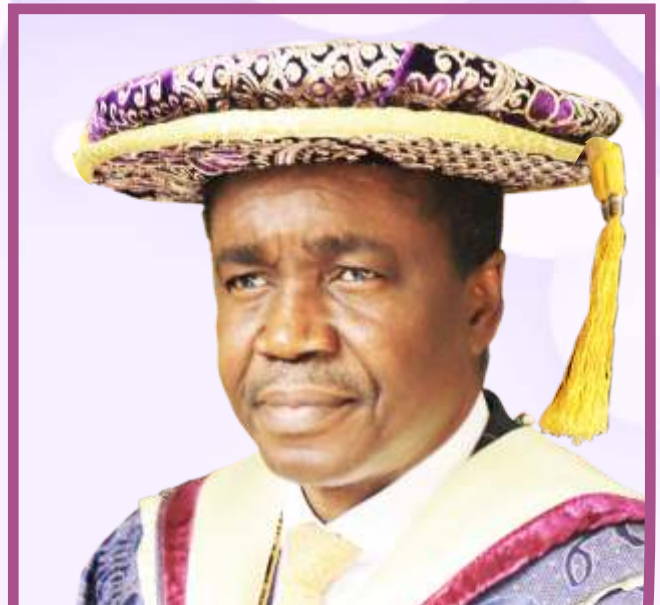
Perhaps many do not understand why graduation is described as commencement. It's a day of venturing into actualizing discoveries made in the four corners of the Institution by engaging the force of courage.

Covenant Graduates Bags the SME Awards

They emerged among the 129 candidates selected across 25 different sectors out of the 5,000 nominees shortlisted for the awards. SME100 Africa is a Social Enterprise that provides a platform to empower young entrepreneurs (under the age of 25) and small and medium-scale enterprises to scale and thrive in Africa successfully.

Covenant Students Selected to attend IMF Programme

Covenant University's students were selected from the three Universities invited to attend the International Monetary Fund (IMF) Regional Outreach Mission to Sub-Saharan Africa programme. The programme aimed to engage and interact with students to become potential economists at the International Monetary Fund.

Covenant Programme Got International Accreditation Status

The Biochemistry postgraduate programmes (MSc, MPhil/Ph.D, and Ph.D) received a 5-year full accreditation status from the Royal Society of Biology (RSB) of the United Kingdom. Further to this accreditation, the final-year undergraduate students of Biochemistry will receive one year of free membership in the Royal Society of Biology. This network will further serve as professional leverage for our students when applying for jobs.

Five undergraduate students in the Department of Business Management bagged the Future Leaders in Marketing Awards 2022. Ogundipe Oluwaseun Victoria won the first position, while Babafemi Oreoluwa David took the 3rd award.

Covenant Center of Excellence Receives Additional Grant from the World Bank

The Covenant Applied Informatics and Communication Africa Center of Excellence (CApIC-ACE) have been recommended for an additional fund of about 1 million dollars from the World Bank. This is attributed to her excellent performance at a recent mid-term review of all centers in the country. CapIC-ACE is among the top 8 centres in Nigeria and the second among the new Nigerian world bank centres of excellence. The center which earlier won 5 million dollars grant was instituted to conduct research in malaria, breast & prostate cancer and evolve a Federated Genomic (FEDGEN) cloud infrastructure for informatics-based genomic research in Africa.

Graduating Class

It gives me great pleasure to state that our life-applicable and transformative educational model has produced this 17th set of Eagles that we are celebrating today. A total of 1,934 graduands shall be conferred with first and higher degrees in various disciplines. The breakdown shows that 1,677 Bachelor's and 257 higher degrees will be awarded to the graduating class, having been found worthy in character and in learning. In the Bachelor's degree category, 206 (12.28%) of the graduands made First Class, while 744 (44.36%) are in the Second Class (Upper Division). Also, 620 (36.97%) of the graduands are in the Second Class

(Lower Division), and 107 (6.38%) of the graduands are in the Third Class category.

In the higher degree category, there are 77 persons bagging the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree. In the Master's degree category, there are one hundred and fourteen (114) persons graduating with the Master of Science (M.Sc.) degree; while thirty-nine (39) will be obtaining the Master of Engineering (M.Eng.) degree. For Master of Arts (MA), only seven (7) persons are being conferred with the degree. Also, in the professional graduate programme category, twenty (20) of the graduands are being awarded Master in Business Administration (MBA).

Concluding Remarks

At this juncture, I want to say unequivocally that all these achievements and accolades have been by the hand of God who is the Founder, the Funder, and the Runner of Covenant University. We return all the glory to Him.

I heartily congratulate all the graduating class for this remarkable feat. There is no doubt that Covenant has invested and equipped you adequately to be able to identify and optimize great opportunities that come your way and be able to turnaround the destiny of our nation and by extension, the African continent. As you are released today, may you continue to soar as eagles, become worthy ambassadors of Covenant, pride to our continent and walk the path that glorifies the kingdom of God.

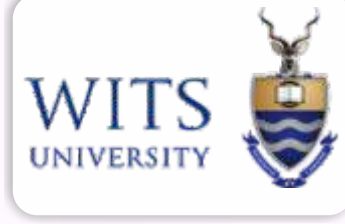

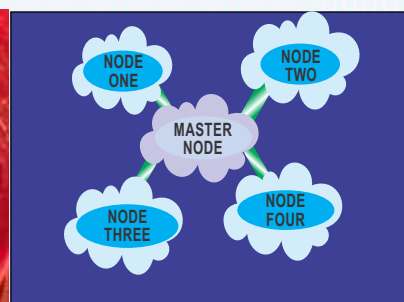
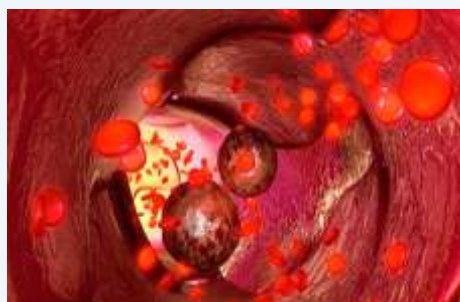
