COREN Accredits Covenant University Engineering Programmes

The Council for the Regulation of Engineering in Nigeria (COREN) has approved full Accreditation status for five Engineering programmes offered by Covenant University

The five Engineering programmes are Mechanical Engineering, Electrical/Electronic Engineering, Computer Engineering, Petroleum Engineering and Civil Engineering.

The effective date of accreditation according to the Registrar was March 29, 2012, which would be valid for five years.

He strongly advised the University to ensure that the standards were not only maintained but improved upon.

While conveying the cheering news of the accreditation to some of the Principal Officers of the University, the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Aize Obayan noted that it was validating news of God's faithfulness.
